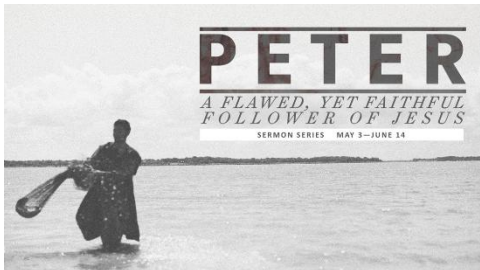


## Please note for June, July and August the Sunday morning service will begin at 10:30am

Through Peter's life, we are reminded that God does not require perfection, but faith that grows through grace. His story offers hope to all who struggle, fail, and rise again, showing that flawed people can still be used powerfully by a faithful God.
